

## ENROUTE TO U. S. A.

MAY 2, 1945 - WAS DELOUSED AND ALERTED TO MOVE  
AT 5:30 AM TOMORROW.

MAY 3, 1945 - LEFT CAMP AT 6:45 A.M. MARCHED OUTSIDE  
CAMP TO WHERE WE LOADED ON G.I. TRUCKS. WERE  
TAKE TO AN AIRFIELD JUST OUTSIDE LANDSHUT.  
STAYED AT LANDSHUT FROM 8:30 A.M. ON THROUGH  
THE DAY AND NIGHT. ALL THE PLANES NEEDED DID  
NOT COME IN. STAYED IN GERMAN CADET BARRACKS

MAY 4, 1945 - GOT UP AT 6:30 A.M. HAD CHICKEN STEW  
AND K-RATIONS FOR BREAKFAST. WENT OUT TO THE  
AIR FIELD AT 8:30 A.M. TO WAIT FOR THE PLANES  
TO COME IN. WE WAITED UNTIL 4:30 P.M. WITH NO  
PLANES ARRIVING WE FINALLY LEFT AND WENT BACK  
TO THE BARRACKS. WERE ISSUED K-RATIONS FOR CHOW.  
IN THE EVENING THE RED CROSS ISSUED DONUTS AND  
SHOWED THE MOVIE, "SWEET AND LOW DOWN" WITH BENNY  
GOODMAN'S ORCHESTRA AND LYNN BARI.

MAY 5, 1945 - GOT UP AT 7:45 A.M. HAD A ROLL CALL AT 8:00  
A.M. WE DIDN'T GO OUT TO THE AIR FIELD AS THE  
WEATHER WAS BAD. THERE WERE NO PLANES CAME IN  
SO WE STAYED IN THE BARRACKS ALL DAY. WE WERE  
ISSUED K-RATIONS AND 2 RED CROSS PARCEL FOR 6  
MEN

MAY 6, 1945 - GOT UP AT 7:45 A.M. WHEN TOM BROUGHT US  
OUR COFFEE FOR BREAKFAST. HAD A ROLL CALL
