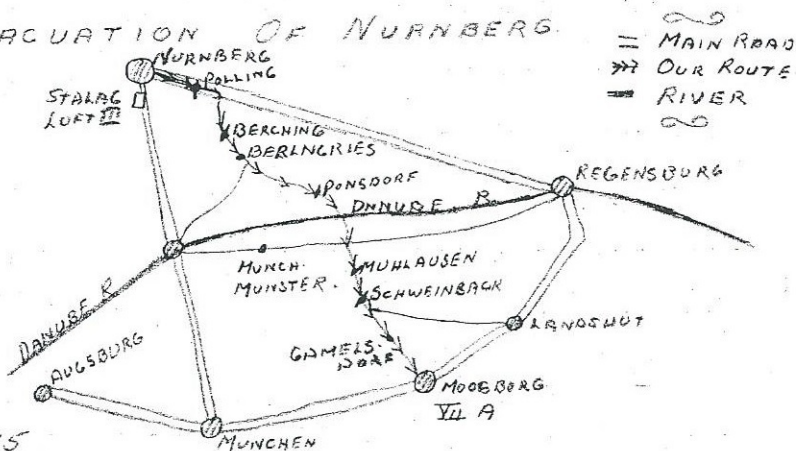


EVACUATION OF NURNBERG.
