MAY 7, 1945 - GOT UP AT 7:45 WHEN JOE BROUGHT US
OUR COFFEE AND BREAD. HAD ROLL CALL AT 8:30
AND THEN MARCHED OUT TO THE FIELD. TOM
BROUGHT US COFFEE FOR DINNER SHIPS FINALLY
CAME IN AND I CLIMBED ON BOARD AT 1:30 P.M.
AND TOOK OFF AT 2:30 P.M. WE LANDED AT
THIONVILLE AT 4:30 P.M. TOOK OFF AT 5:45 P.M. AND
LANDED IN LE HARVE AT 7:45 P.M. WAS DELOUSED
AND PUT IN TENTS FOR THE NIGHT AT CAMP LUCKY STRIKE

MAY 8, 9, 10, 1945 SPENT THESE DAYS PROCESSING
GOT CLOTHS, SHOTS AND FORMS FILLED OUT. AND
GOT PAID THEN WAITED TO SHIP OUT. IN THE
EVENING OF THE 10TH. WAS MOVED TO PENDING
SHIPPING.

MAY 11, 12, 1945 SPENT IN SHIPPING AREA. WAS PUT ON
SHIPPING ORDERS THE 12TH.

MAY 13, 1945. MOTHER'S DAY - GOT UP AT 4:00 A.M. AS
WE WERE TO SHIP OUT. LOADED ON TRUCKS
AND CAME PART WAY TO LE HARVE. WE
